North Coast All-Breeds Youth Classic

The members of Gelbvieh Youth Australia would like to extend an invitation to all young beef cattle enthusiasts between the ages of 8-25, to join the members of the Gelbvieh Youth movement for a weekend full of Education and Information about the Beef Cattle Industry.

Camp Dates: 8th, 9th and 10th of June 2018

Camp Location: Lismore Showgrounds

Camp Cost: \$120.00 Per Entrant -. This includes 1 year Junior membership with The Australian Gelbvieh Association \$60.00 for attending Parents/ Guardians – Camp Shirt NOT Included

Arrival Time: Friday Morning for a 9 am Start, for interstate or long distance travellers are more than welcome to arrive lunch time Thursday

Departure Time: Cattle depart Lismore show grounds no earlier than 2 pm, interstate or long distance travellers are welcome to stay Sunday night, departing by 10 am Monday Morning.

Ballot Cattle: As part of our youth experience, we will provide Ballot animals for entrants that are unable to supply their own animals. However in order for us to offer this experience, we heavily rely on the support from our Gelbvieh and many other Breeders. Exhibitors supplying cattle, please state what shirt size you would like to receive.

Cattle Regulations: Participants under the age of 18 are only allocated one animal. If participants are over the age of 18, they may nominate a second animal. With knowledge that the Camp Committee reserves the right to use the second entry as a possible ballot animals if deemed necessary.

Heifers are to be under the age of 24 months as of the 1st June 2018. Any animals exceeding this age or with Calf at foot, will be Entered into Cow Classes. Calves are not to exceed the maximum age of 9 months.

Steers are not have any permanent teeth, milk tooth only.

All animals must be Tractable, failure to comply with this ruling will result in the animal not being allocated.

NO BULL ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.

Animal Entry Forms: Entry forms available for studs who are intending on bringing entries/ballot cattle, please fill out all information on this form, including any pre-allocated animals. Please also fill out the experience level of the entries in the Level column.

Herd Declaration: Herd Declaration forms are a requirement upon entering cattle. Please send this declaration accompanying entry form.

Pestivirus Testing: All cattle entering New South Wales Must be pestivirus tested, we require a copy of the test results with entries. Failure to provide testing results, cattle will be illegible to remain on grounds.

Spraying: New South Wales is a tick free area. **ALL** cattle within tick infected areas are required to be sprayed before entering New South Wales. This will require booking in at the relevant spraying stations prior to commencing movement. Upon arrival you may be asked to provide your spray certificate.

We understand that this comes at an addition cost and can be extra work for breeders and exhibitors. But we trust that you have an understanding of the importance of protecting yourself and other from disease and parasites.

CAMP RULES



Entrants:

- Entrants ages are to be over the age of 8 (Eight) , and no older then 25 (Twenty-Five).
- Any entrants under the age of 18 must have parental consent to attend the camp.
- Any minors (Under 16 years) MUST have a Parent or Guardian on grounds at all times.
- No alcohol is to be consumed by **ANY** camp participants. If alcohol is consumed, then the participant will be asked to remove themselves from the camp.
- No participants are to exit camp grounds, unless it is for emergency purposes.
- Participants who leave the grounds, must notify the camp committee. The 2018 Gelbvieh Youth Camp Committee will take no responsibility for the safety, care or behaviour of any participants who exit venue grounds.
- No smoking in camping areas/shed, cattle stalls, toilets and showers.
- Appropriate footwear is to be worn at all times. Sneakers, Thongs or Canvas shoes are not permitted around cattle.
- Drug use is prohibited, alongside any illegal or harmful acts upon yourself and/or other participants. Result of this will be involvement of law services and prosecution.
- No dogs are to be within the cattle stalling or ring areas.
- Any participants acting disruptively or unacceptably will be immediately disqualified.
- Whilst everything is done to ensure the safety of participants and their animals, every care will be taken by those in charge. The Gelbvieh Youth Camp Committee is not responsible for any accident or sickness that may occur, through any source whatsoever. It must be clearly understood that each participant will only be permitted to attend the Handlers Camp on the understanding that the parent/guardian (if participant is under 18) signs a consent form and agrees to indemnify the committee against any claim.

Exhibitors:

- Stud Females must be registered with a relevant breed society. Documentation of registration will be required upon receiving entries.
- Led steers/Heifers can be pure or crossbred, however must still be milk tooth.
- Stud Heifers nominated in stud classes, cannot be nominated in led steer/heifer classes
- The use of nose grips or rings, will be required to be used for animals over 6 months at **ALL** times.
- Neck ropes are compulsory when bedding cattle.
- Exhibitors must have insurance and/or liability for their exhibits, a copy of this will be mandatory.
- Exhibitors are to provide their own equipment and feed for their cattle.
- Straw bedding supplied.
- Inspectors nominated by the camp committee will be inspecting nlis tags, Tattoos and/or firebrands/freeze brands on arrival. Incorrect or illegible tattoos will lead to disqualification. As well as inexistent nlis tag. Brands are optional in New South Wales.
- Animal substitution is permitted as long as committee is notified prior or at arrival.
- **ALL EXHIBITORS' ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT MUST HAVE AN IN-LINE CIRCUIT BREAKER AND ALL POWER LEADS MUST HAVE A CURRENT CERTIFICATE OT TAG FROM A REGISTERED ELECTRICIAN AS REQUIRED BY LAW. INSPECTION WILL BE CARRIED OUT.**
- **ALL ENTRIES TO BE ACCOMPANIED BY THE ENCLOSED HEALTH DECLARATION AND MUST BE DERIVED FROM A BRUCELLOSIS, TUBERCULOSIS AND JHONES FREE HERD.**
- Animals must be Pestivirus tested and free, a copy of results in mandatory. Failure to supply results will result in having to return to property of origin
- JBAS Score must be 6 or higher
